• Built Environment With Ramps / Lifts For Easy Access To Classrooms -

Ramps are built for convenience of the Divyangjan student. They provide easy access to them.

• Disabled-friendly Washrooms

Western toilet blocks are made available to the Divyangjan student and a non-teaching staff.

• Provision for Inquiry and Information: Human Assistance, Reader, Scribe, Soft Copies Of Reading Material, Screen Reading

- The PWD (Persons with Disabilities) students with 40% and above disability are provided with reservation quota during admission.
- The concerned admission committee guides the Divyangjan students in admission process.
- The concerned mentors and the office counsel and provide all possible assistance to the Divyangjan students for filling in examination forms, Government Scholarships available, enrolment for skill development courses, etc. to enable them pursue hasslefree education.
- The Divyangjan students are given special attention during examinations. There is a provision of PWD stamp.
- Soft copies / hard copies of the study material are provided for their convenience.
- They are provided with scribe on demand.
- They are given extra time as per rule during examination
- Not only the teachers and mentors but their classmates too offer them help regarding study material, important notices, etc.
- The concerned teachers accompany them for the workshops or conferences conducted for them by the university.
