


India – Pakistan Partition

More than 565 states of various sorts.

About 210 are commonly listed as "states", ruled by potentates with a variety of titles, such as Raja, Maharaja, Nawab, Khan or Nizam. The rest were "estates" (jagir), "estate revenue grants" (thikana), and "land holders" (zamindar), with jagirdars, thakurs, or zamindarsno of gretarer or lesser prominence and title. Only 21 had actual state governments, and only three were large (Mysore, Hyderabad and Kashmir).

Partition of India, 1947







